Fred Hankins was one of the outstanding photographers in the world. He was a charter member of Taft Camera Club in 1933 and a founding member of PSA. Fred enjoyed national and international acclaim as a Black and White desert photographer, particularly the sand dunes of Death Valley. In three decades, Fred had explored the desert extensively and captured the many scenes and moods of the Ibex sand dunes in classic Black and White. In addition to winning many awards in PSA-recognized International Exhibitions, Fred's prints were internationally recognized in six continents of the globe.

This program is a collection of many of Fred's outstanding black and white desert prints, made by Taft Camera Club in honor of Fred. Thanks to the generosity of Taft Camera Club and the members of the Hankins family; a copy was given to PSA to be included in the PSA program library for PSA members/clubs.
